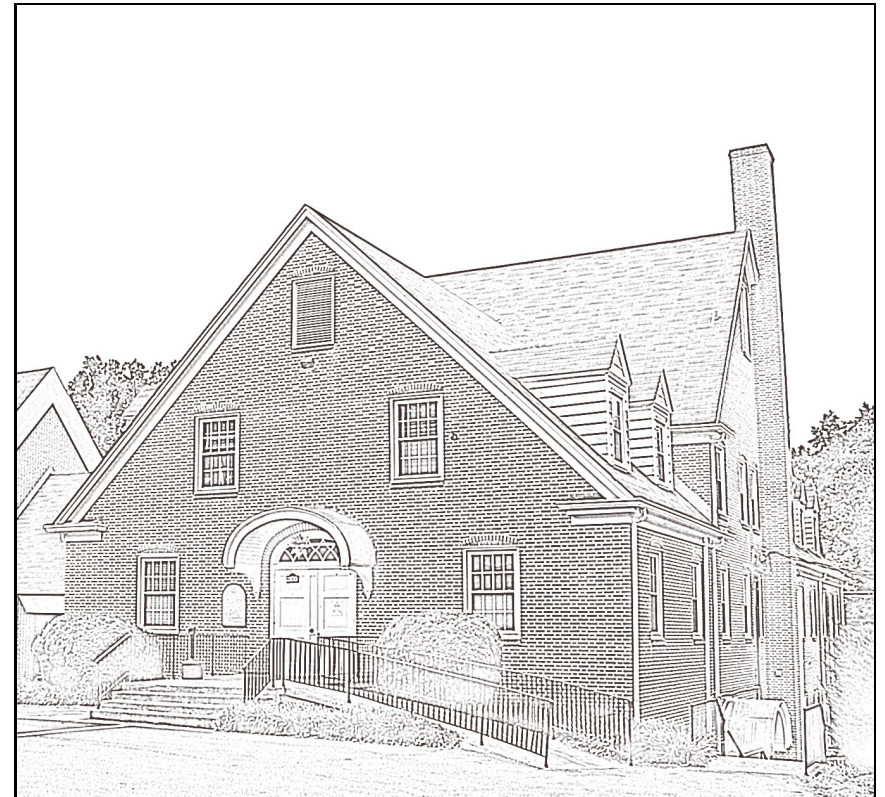

~ SCRIPTURE LESSON ~

John 1:1-5, 9-18

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2** He was in the beginning with God; **3** all things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. **4** In him was life, and the life was the light of men. **5** The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. **9** The true light that enlightens every man was coming into the world. **10** He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world knew him not. **11** He came to his own home, and his own people received him not. **12** But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God; **13** who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. **14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father. **15** (John bore witness to him, and cried, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, for he was before me.'") **16** And from his fullness have we all received, grace upon grace. **17** For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. **18** No one has ever seen God; the only Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, he has made him known.

~ SAGRADAS ESCRITURAS ~

San Juan 1:1-19

1 En el principio era el Verbo, y el Verbo era con Dios, y el Verbo era Dios. **2** Este era en el principio con Dios. **3** Todas las cosas por él fueron hechas, y sin él nada de lo que ha sido hecho, fue hecho. **4** En él estaba la vida, y la vida era la luz de los hombres. **5** La luz en las tinieblas resplandece, y las tinieblas no prevalecieron contra ella.
