Pray Everyday Day

1. Lift the leaders of your congregation and all of our Moravian churches. Pray for the newly elected board members as they settle into their specific leadership roles. roles
2. Pray for the many people who continue to suffer from the effects of hurricanes and tornadoes, of flooding and drought. God how He would have you support them.
3. May we enter this season of Lent with an attitude of humbleness. Let us learn to walk daily with our Lord, learn to show mercy to those in our lives and those God gives the opportunity to minister to.
4. Lift the schools in prayer today. Ask God to put them on your heart as the day goes by. Pray for protection and peace for the students and the teachers. Pray for seminarians and professors
5. "... by waters calm, o're troubled sea' still 'tis God's hand hat leadeth me." No matter what comes into my life today, I thank you Jesus for your eternal presence in my life. Help me to live in such a way that others will want to know You.
6. **Sunday.** This is he Lord's day. Worship Him in truth and in sincerity. Pray for those who worship Him in spite of dire persecution. Ask for protection and mercy for them and for those who support them.
7. There are many suffering from HIV/Aids in many places where our church is trying to bring help and healing. Lord, bless Kim Bartholomew and others who care for the ill, and those who care for the orphans created by Aids.
8. Pray for those who are ill and /or lonely, those who are incarcerated and for those who are living in institutions of various kinds. Ask God to send his love to them in the form of loving Christian people.
9. Pray for the people of Hooper Bay Alaska . They filled the new church (built by Samaritan's Purse volunteers) during the Christmas season. Pray that many people there will begin to live daily for Him.
10. Alaska Christian College is an educational ministry of the Evangelical Covenant Church of Alaska "preparing young people for whole-life discipleship. Pray for students & staff.
11. Thank God for organizations that make it so easy for us to help those in need. Ask Him to show you how to support those that reach the hurting, hungry people in your town.
12. Pray that a lot more congregations will join with the Board of World Mission and the Moravian Church of Western Tanzania in Adopting A Village to care for orphans and fight the effects of HIV/AIDS.
13. **Sunday.** "Be glad in the Lord and rejoice." Prepare your heart to receive the word of the Lord for you today. Ask God to speak to your heart and to give you the strength and the vision to take that word into your life.
14. Spend your prayer time today in praise, adoration and thanksgiving. Seek His presence; thank Him for who He is. Praise Him for his grace and mercy.
15. Pray for the recently established Mountain Laurel Moravian Fellowship in Laurel Springs , near our beloved Moravian camp. Ask God to fill them with His Holy Spirit and to send many who need Him to their door.
16. Pray for Bernie Fisher and Sandra's House in Zona Maya Mexico (www.sandrashouse.org) as many volunteers join him in ministering to children in Mexico .
17. Pray for Lisa Mixon and Sheila Beaman who administer the Northern and Southern Mission Offices respectively. They are blessed with numerous opportunities of witness each day and are great blessings to us. Thank Jesus for them and His presence in their lives.
18. Pray earnestly for Safiatu and Mohamed Braima, from the Little Church on the Lane in Charlotte , and the Luawa-Yiehun Community Church in Sierra Leone . Pray that they may soon have enough support to build a school.
19. Pray for Will Sibert and his family. Pray for the Board of World Mission as they move into a season of preparation for their spring meeting. Ask God to bless them with discernment and wisdom and great opportunity for ministry and witness.
20. **Sunday.** Lord prepare me to be a sanctuary" Fill me with your Holiness, forgive my indiscretions, use my weakness and my willingness in witness to your greatness and your mercy and love.
21. Pray for Sam Gray as he directs the intercultural ministries and communications of the Moravian Church in North America and around the world for us. Pray for good health and great discernment.
22. Pray for Mark Ebert as he coordinates and directs the numerous volunteers who are sent. Thank God for his faith and enthusiasm and his willingness to go and to serve.
23. Name all the names of missionaries you can in our prayers today. Ask God for protection, for open doors, for wisdom in their ministry and most of all, for God's will be done.
24. "Breathe on me breath of God."
25. Father, show us the beautiful ministry of St. Francis of Assisi. May it bring freshness to our ministries.
26. Let's read the books of Luke and Acts in one sitting for new and greater understanding of the events of Lent.
27. **Sunday.** All glory and honor to You this day Lord. May our worship bring joy to You and strengthen us in our ministry for You this coming week. 28. Oh Lord—bring new and clear understanding of Jesus to those who are learning of Him for the FIRST time today.
