3. Prince of Peace, what a name, celebrates its founding. May our Lord bless them. Pray for Bishop Sam Gray and Rev Will Sibert that their trip to EWI for a Mission Conference celebrating the 550th Anniversary of the Moravian Church will be an encouragement to those there.
4. **Sunday** On this Sunday, the second Sunday in Lent, ask the Holy Spirit to rest on our churches as they worship the King of Kings.

14. Pray for Sister Kim Bartholomew as she serves the Board of World Mission as the HIV/AIDS coordinator. Continue to pray for victims of this pandemic, especially the little orphans.
15. Pray for our lord's ministry here in Congo, I would like The Almighty God our Father to bless all His work

- our leader and through your prayer, may God attend all Moravians who are putting His word into practice
16. As Congolese Moravians, we would like our country to change, having some qualities of other Moravians in the World. We wish to have also some Congolese Pastors who can go to preach the Gospel of God all over the World. May our God continue to give wisdom to our chairman and much strength.

  20. Pray today for the women who met in Winston Salem to make preparations for the third Unity Consultation of Women. It is to be in Herrnhut in 2009.
  21. Pray for the persecuted Christians in Chad. The number of believers continues to grow in spite of severe persecution.
  25. **Sunday** The Lord's Day. Pray for your church and Sunday School, pastor, teachers circle leaders elders and trustees by name. Pray for Bishop Sam Gray, Br. Otto Dreydoppel of Moravian Theological Seminary, and Rev. Will Sibert as they travel to Thailand to work with BEE World about educational opportunities for US pastors and for our partner provinces.

  28. Pray for Mohammed and Safiatu Braima (Christians from the Little Church on the Lane in Charlotte) now missionaries in Sierra Leone, Africa. Offer praises for their safe travel.
  29. Ask God to call into His service men like Jon Amos Comenius whose birthday is today. (3/29/1582) Pray for all Christian teachers.
  30. Pray these words often: Jesus Christ, Lamb of God, You take away the sins of the world; give unto us your peace.
  31. Use both your hymnal and your Bible in your prayer time at home today. Pray out loud and also in silence. Sit quietly before Jesus and let Him speak to you.
