

- 1 Prepare for a new month of opportunity to pray every day for the missions of our church, the worldwide Moravian Church and all those serving in long term and short term mission. Let's begin with those serving in the Gulf coast reconstruction.
- 2 Pray for your family and those in your church that share in the mission outreach of individuals, in scouts, men and women fellowships, youth fellowships, and any groups using your facilities, such as AA, Alanon, Hispanic ministry, and day care service.
- 3 Support those preparing for worship tomorrow; pastors, organists, choir directors, band members, singers and all who lead our worship. Remember Church school teachers, superintendents and all who come to learn. May we all be enriched and prepared to go out into the mission field.
- 4 SUNDAY – "I was glad when they said let us go up to the house of the Lord." Bless all who seek to know more of the Lord's will for each of us in the Lord's house.
- 5 We pray for our churches in the dangerous places; such as the Holy Land, Africa, Northern Ireland and Cuba. May we who live in safer places try to bring peace and stability to them.
- 6 There are many suffering from HIV/Aids in many places where our church is trying to bring help and healing; bless those who care for the ill, and bless those who care for the orphans created by Aids.
- 7 Many are working full time in various agencies serving a specific group or need. Assure them of your abiding presence. Bless the people of Labrador who are working there to bring the power of the Gospel to those who need it so badly.
- 8 Missionaries now answering God's call by serving Him in their native village in Sierra Leone. Pray hard for them; they need our continuous prayers for strength, courage, protection, hope and financial support. This is an exciting breakthrough in Moravian mission. - 9 Glenna Tasedan, editor of Onward and Helen Gulledge, Coordinator, Pray Every Day and Prayer Focus, important vessels for keeping all of us focused on mission.
- 10 Brad Bennett, Chris Geisler, and Sam Gray have begun work for establishing a school of Moravian Music and Worship in Costa Rica. Pray that this exciting ministry which began IN Nepal last year, will continue to multiply and bring glory to the name of Jesus.
- 11 SUNDAY – Please pray for Evon Crooks, president of the Mission Society, and for the other directors. All are welcome at their monthly meeting on the third Tuesday evening at Ardmore Moravian Church. Call the Mission Office if you are interested.
- 12 Please pray today for Deanna Hollenbach, editor of The Moravian, an important tool for keeping us informed of mission in motion here in our own country.
- 13 Anna Smith, president of the Cherokee-Moravian Historical Association, Inc. involved in reconnecting the historical relationship between the Cherokee Nation and our Moravian Church. Learn more about this piece of our history in mission.
- 14 Will Sibert, executive director of the Board of World Mission as we are beginning to feel fresh winds of the Holy Spirit blowing over us in new and exciting mission breakthroughs in our world-wide Unity. Ask God to make you one of the sparks that spread the flame.
- 15 Pray for boldness when you have the opportunity to witness to the wonders and grace of our Lord, and His every lasting kingdom. [DT refers to the Moravian Daily Text reading for that day] Ask Him to give you specific opportunities and people to pray for.
- 16 Pray for the focus of all Moravians in our nineteen provinces to be on Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. Pray for reconciliation in order that we become good witnesses for Him.
- 17 Pray for those who are discouraged, depressed, disappointed, and despairing, that they might put their trust in God. [DT] Ask God to show you who you need to pray for.
- 18 SUNDAY – The last Sunday after Epiphany. Pray for those in your congregation who have yet to establish a personal relationship with Jesus. [DT] Ask Jesus how you can be instrumental in furthering their walk with him.
- 19 Pray that we might seek and use the gifts of the Spirit in our ministry to others. [DT] If you do not know what your specific gifts are, take one of the many good tests that reveal your gifts.
- 20 Pray for the spirit of humility to overshadow our dealings with others, be they Christian or non-Christian. [DT] May we always seek to reflect Jesus in all we do and say.
- 21 Ash Wednesday. "Spirit", lead us to those who might perish without knowing their Savior. [DT] Pray that God will give you a special time with Him today.
- 22 Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, early in the morning our song shall rise to Thee. Hear our prayer, I love Thee.
- 23 Jesus' name, Jesus' name (Moravian hymn). Spend time simply praising Jesus. Let's center our thoughts on Him for 10 or 15 minutes.
- 24 Pray often for your country, your church, our schools and colleges. Pray for Sunday School teachers and pastors as they prepare to teach and preach tomorrow.
- 25 SUNDAY – At home today let's pray for each person whose name was mentioned or printed in your church bulletin. Ask how you can help them.
- 26 In many churches only one third of the members are in church on any given Sunday. Tell people that you missed them. Pray for them before you telephone them.
- 27 Pray for MOTOR RACING OUTREACH (Nascar racing community) the wives of drivers, crew chiefs, shop workers. They meet every Wednesday in the New Beginnings Moravian Church in Huntersville, NC.
- 28 Every Wednesday, Pastor Chris Thore teaches the Bethel Bible Course to 40 to 80 of the above mentioned women. Pray for them. Ask God to bless their children's ministry.
