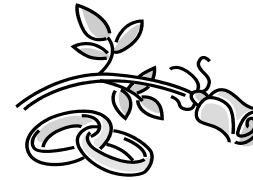

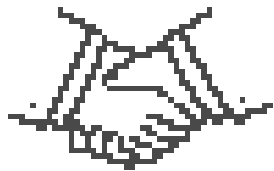

**Jingle Offering  
August 30th**

On Sunday, August 30th, there will be a “**Jingle Offering**” taken for George Goff, Missionary Pilot for Alas de Socorro (Wings of Mercy) located in the La Mosquitia region of Honduras. For ten years, George served as a pilot in Honduras with Missionary Aviation Fellowship (MAF). When MAF closed it’s Honduras operation in 1996, one airplane was left in George’s care at the base in Ahuas. The Reformed church in America and the **Moravian Church** now support this important ministry. The ministry provides transportation for sick people, missionaries, pastors, church workers, and others who must travel to remote villages. George, a devout Christian, has been serving his neighbors and God since 1988 by flying in Honduras. The **Jingle Offering** will go to help with the repairs on the Wings of Mercy airplane.

Dear Friends,

You have read about the fire at the Adler's Point Apartments, which is located in Sunnyside's serve area. Currently, 97 residents have been displaced. Many left their apartments with nothing more than the clothes they were wearing. One gentleman came to us for help, having lost everything including his car which was damaged by falling debris.

We are asking for special donations for these neighbors. We particularly need household goods such as sheets, towels, dishes, silverware, pots and pans. We have adequate outerwear, but need underwear for men and women. Hygiene items such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shaving items, and deodorant would also be appreciated.
