BMC Clothes Closet Report for December 20th

We had a total of **31 shoppers** today and gave out almost **600 articles of clothing** and **home goods**. The home goods and children's toys and games were in demand this month. In order to give everyone a chance to shop, we had to limit their time to 10 minutes. Even then, we didn't get everyone processed until after 12:30pm.

Once again this month, we were able to help The Dream Center with over 500 clothing items. They delivered several cases of brand new Hanes sweatshirts and cases of packs of Hygiene products to us. (Washcloth, soap, shaving kits, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.). We also gave them new blankets that the Women's Fellowship donated through a blanket drive named "Now I lay me down to sleep" for the unhoused population. The need is great, and the collection bin will remain in the vestibule for January also. So far, Bethabara has donated a total of **41 new blankets**.

Our Clothes Closet Team is very dedicated to our mission to clothe and assist anyone in need. We meet regularly every Tuesday to process clothing and home goods in order to be a blessing on the 3rd Saturday each month. Thank you to everyone who helps in any way. Even the smallest gesture or donation means a lot to those in need.
