We had a busy day today in the Clothes Closet! Our total number of <u>items distributed was 904</u> plus a case of brand new men's underwear that probably contained 100 items. We had a total of <u>30 shoppers</u>. In order to allow everyone in line to shop, we had to limit their shopping time in the Clothes Closet, and we actually had to stay open past closing time.

A group of social workers at Carter High School came today with their special needs students and their parents. This was their first time at Bethabara, and they were overwhelmed with our generosity. They have ages 16 through 22, and the need for clothing is great. Many students don't have any clothing so the school keeps a clothing locker at the school for them. That is where the case of men's underwear was donated.

Earlier this month we were able to help The Dream Center with donations of 327 items of men's and women's clothing and shoes. They serve many people who have no place to live. Thank you for all your donations and for allowing us to be a blessing in our community!
