# I Clothes Closet Report for June, 2025.....

June has been a busy month in the Clothes Closet! We were open on Saturday, June 21, 2025, and we had 28 shoppers and distributed 527 articles of clothing, shoes and household items in 2 hours. In addition to our normal shopping day this month, we received a record number of donations, and we have also received a large number of requests for clothing needs from other agencies. In the past few years, we have partnered with The Dream Center, and they have provided us with brand new clothing on a regular basis. This month, they moved to a larger facility on North Liberty Street, and they now have many more people requesting clothing each week. Thanks to our generous donations, we were able to help The Dream Center twice this month in their emergency need with clothing, shoes, towels and I blankets. They have a large homeless population nearby who depend on them for basic needs. A total of over 500 items were donated from Bethabara. The Forsyth County Detention Center I sent out an urgent need for men's clothing, underwear and I socks. We were happy to share some of our inventory with them I and delivered 257 items of clothing to their office.

I Several other requests were received along with a special I need from Fairview Moravian Church's Clothes Closet and all I were provided the requested items. Many, many bags of cloth-I ing were donated to us from Salemtowne and other individuals I (some of them we don't even know who to thank because they I just miraculously appear).

After all of the above donations were completed, our grand total for the month of June is 1,992!! We depend on our amazing volunteers who give their time, talent and treasure to serve others, and also to those who generously donate clothing and household goods every month.

Thanks to everyone who has supported our Back-to-School Drive with your donations! We will be distributing the stuffed backpacks on Saturday, July 19, 2025. There's still time for you to bring items in for this effort.
