Today was a very hot day, but that didn't stop our shoppers. We had a total of 35 people who braved the heat and waited outside for their turn to shop. In order to be able to allow everyone a chance to shop in the 2-hour time we are open, we have to limit each shopper to 10 minutes. It was still 12:30 before everyone finished, and we didn't have to turn anyone away. Those 35 people received a total of 635 items.

Recently, we have been in touch with a teacher who is setting up a clothing ministry for students and their parents. She will meet with us at our Clothes Closet next week, and we are already preparing clothing from our closet to donate to them. This teacher and her family were members of Bethabara for many years until she left for college. It has been great making a connection with her again, and we look forward to helping her get started.

The Dream Center on Liberty Street needed men's clothing so we provided around 400 items for them. They support many unhoused people in their neighborhood.

Many of our shoppers mentioned how pleased they were to meet Pastor Tony today. He was out in the heat greeting people and talking to them while they were waiting. He also talked to the people in line for food. And that was a long line of cars!
